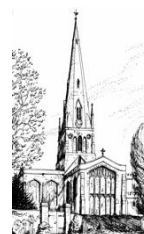

**THE REVD KEITH ROBINSON** died on 8<sup>th</sup> June aged 76 after a long illness.  
 Keith was a popular curate at All Saints during the period of the fire, he was a gifted  
 priest going on to become Rector of St Martins church, one of the oldest in Salisbury.  
 He was also a fine artist and led a great deal of the research which helped to identify the  
 figures carved into the roofs of the church. He drew the sketch of the church which  
 adorns the weekly newsheet. He joined the Roman Catholic Church through the  
 Ordinariate and lived in Herefordshire with his wife Christine. They had 3 children.
